# Further details – the rules.



Normal cricket rules will apply at all times with the following additional rules:

- 1 Each team will have 6 players
- 2 An innings will consist of 10 overs per side. 1 hour is allocated per game
- 3 Each player must bowl 2 overs each, excluding the wicket keeper who will not bowl.
- 4 Batsman can be out as per normal cricket rules but must retire at 25. Retiring batsman can return to the crease later. The innings will close at the fall of the 5<sup>th</sup> wicket.
- 5 A batsman can be caught out off the side walls or ceiling but not the back wall.
- 6 Runs can be scored as follows:
  - 1 run if the ball is hit onto a side wall, hits the wall, or lodges in the netting behind the keeper or leaves the arena via the entrance gates.
  - 2 runs if batsman run a single, ----- 3 runs if a side wall is hit and the batsmen run a single.
  - 4 runs if the ball hits the back wall without touching a side wall/ceiling ----- 6 runs if the ball hits the back wall without bouncing or hitting ceiling or side walls first ----- 1 run for overthrow that hits any wall.
- 7 A no- ball will be called for pitching the ball short as per taped line.
- 8 A game will end when the team batting second loses their 6<sup>th</sup> wicket (last man stands), have passed the total set or have received their allocated 10 overs.
- 9 Players must wear batting gloves and protective box and may choose to wear pads if they wish.
- 10 If scores are equal at the end of the game, the side losing the least amount of wickets will win the game.
- 11 If still equal each side will receive 1 over each, with the above rules applying to that 1 over .i.e least number of wickets will apply.
- 12 Each side must supply a scorer.
- 13 Scorers must sit together on the balcony.
- 14 Bowlers run ups will be restricted to 5 paces
- 15 Batters will run to the shortened batting crease at the bowlers end.
- 16 Player eligibility will follow Warwickshire League rules, and any registered player can play.
- 17 Once a team has committed to the league it is committed to the entire program and the costs associated with that program. It is the club that is liable for entry although each match's £15 fee can be paid on the night.
